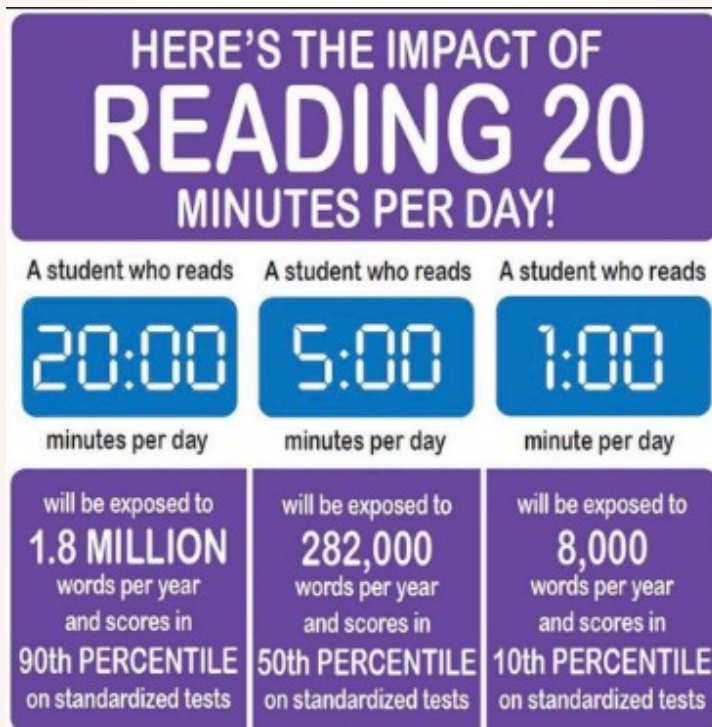
We would like to invite you all to our **'Easter Service'**.
