You can book a time for a chat or talk to a member of staff about a drop in time.



► Why a Quiet Space?



Research shows that giving children a quiet place, where they can go to relax and talk about their worries, allows them to become more emotionally literate and more able to cope with everyday issues.

In our busy lives we all sometimes need a quiet place for contemplation and thinking. Children also feel the stresses of life and at such times they may need help. We aim to provide a safe place for children to go where they can think through a problem or share a worry. The room is designed to support emotional literacy, reinforcing positive behaviour as well as encouraging social interaction.

The hand painted wall display is both soothing and calming, with small details to engage children and aid them in self calming techniques.



Who will use the Quiet Space?

All our children will be welcome to use the room as and when they need it.

Sometimes the room will be for social group activities and at other times it will be a quiet place for just one or two children

At certain times the door will be left open for a drop in activity, usually by invitation from a member of staff for children having a challenging day.

As a safe place the room can only accessed with an adult in support, as the outer door is key coded.

A simple log will be kept of which children work in the room so that staff can ensure the children continue to be supported outside of the Quiet Space.

The names of any children using the room will be confidential in school but parents may be informed with the child's agreement.

What do the children think?
