## SATs MEETINGS for YEARS 2 & 6

We will be holding meetings for parents to explain the expectations of the Standard Attainment Tests that your child will be doing in May as part of the Department for Education requirements.

The meeting will explain the changes and discuss the support that school will be giving to your child during the build up to the tests and how you can support your child at home.

The meetings will take place in school on:

#### Monday 16th January for Year 6 at 5:30pm & Monday 23rd January for Year 2 at 5:30pm

We expect to be finished no later than 6:30pm. There will be an opportunity for you to ask questions and look at some of the new style questions that you child will be experiencing. Please let us know whether you will be attending the meeting or not.

#### <u>UNIFORM</u>

Last year some parents asked the Governors if the children could have a newer style of PE kit. This was discussed at the last Full Governor's meeting and was approved at the meeting in November.

We then liaised with DP Sports who now have the new stock in - hoodies and track pants which are now both available on-line and in the shop.

The hoodies can be worn throughout the week as well as on PE days as they have a logo on them. PE kits fully can be worn on PE or swimming days. The hoodies may be warmer than sweatshirts or cardigans during the winter months. The older style of kit may still be worn, we don't expect you all to go out and buy new kit straight away. Please may we remind you that pupils' own tracksuits should not be worn for PE days as these are not uniform. If they do not have a school PE tracksuit they are expected to come in uniform and change.
