For your information, symptoms of measles are:

high fever, sore, red, eyes (conjunctivitis), cough, aches, and blotchy, red/brown rash.

### FANTASTIC GESTURE




Well done Rose for having over 30cm of hair cut off to donate to the Little Princess Trust.
