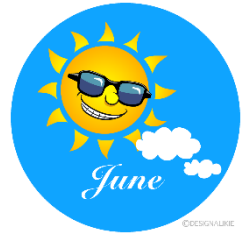

We have been asked to get parents to check whether their child(ren) have received the required two doses of the MMR vaccine – first dose at age 1 and second dose around age 3½. These two doses provide your child with lifelong immunity. If you are unsure, details should be in your child's red book, or you can contact their G.P. to check.

For your information, symptoms of measles are:

high fever, sore, red, eyes (conjunctivitis), cough, aches, and blotchy, red/brown rash.
