UNSUNG HERO AWARD

As we mentioned in last week's newsletter Mr Isherwood was shortlisted for the prestigious award of **Everybody Leisure's Unsung Hero of the Year**.

This award was open to anyone who supports sport in the whole of Cheshire East; over 150 nominations were received by Everybody Leisure. These were then shortlisted to just four individuals, one being Mr Isherwood, for all the time he gives to the school swimming lessons for free.

Mr Isherwood is more qualified than any of the Everybody Leisure Centre staff both pool side and within outdoor swimming, which is one of his hobbies. This year he trained to be a teacher of the Rookie



Lifeguard course for children. Once our pupils meet the National Curriculum requirements, we offer this extra course to them at no charge. This sees Marlfields being the only school to offer this in Cheshire East.

As you may be aware, cohorts Yr 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 swim every week. Mr Isherwood gives his time for free to support the children, as he is passionate about swimming and teaching others to do so effectively. He asks the children their views regularly and plans all the swimming lessons for the centre staff to teach each week.

Mr & Mrs Isherwood attended the awards ceremony last week and are pleased to let you all know that Mr Isherwood **won** the award which was presented to him by Baroness Tanni Grey-Thompson. We are sure you will want to join with us to say a huge thank you for all he does for the school and a huge "**CONGRATULATIONS**" from us all for winning over all the 150 nominations.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS



Do you think your child may be eligible to Free School Meals? If your application is successful, your child will not only get a free lunch, but other benefits too such as vouchers to cover food for the child during school holidays. In December, children already in receipt will get £40 supermarket vouchers.

If your child is in receipt of income related free school meals, they are automatically eligible for the <u>Household Support</u> Fund.

Are you entitled?

You can claim free school meals for each child who attends school in Cheshire East if you receive one of these benefits:

- Universal Credit with no earned income or with net monthly earnings less than £616.67
- Income Support
- Income based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income related Employment Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit as long as you have a yearly household income of less than £16,190 (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs) and do not get Working Tax Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

We suggest you make a claim for free school meals even if your child is in key stage 1 as the school can claim additional funding (pupil premium) for new equipment and resources.

You can also apply for nursery-age children if they attend before and after lunch sessions at a local authority nursery school, nursery class or an Academy nursery if it has the same Ofsted number as the primary school.

It's worth a phone call to see if you are eligible.
