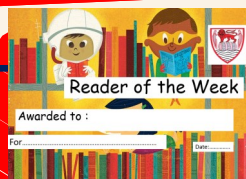

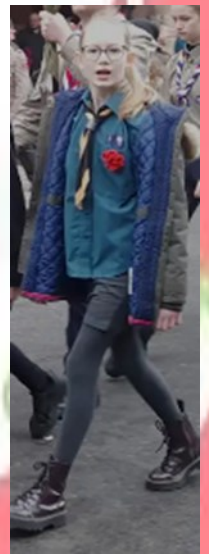

The reason we observe Remembrance Day on 11th November is because the First World War formally ended at the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month in 1918.
