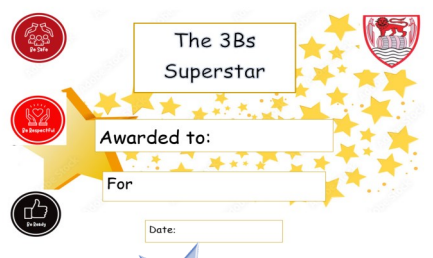

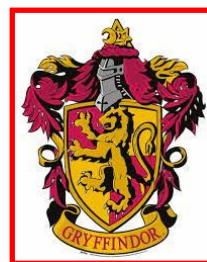

## REMINDERS

May we take this opportunity to remind you of a few things -

### Morning Registration

Please be reminded of the morning routines at school, as per our attendance policy, which can be found on the school website. Our school doors open at 8:45am. Please ensure your child arrives at this time so they are not late for the register. The doors close at 8:55am, along with the external school gates, which close promptly at 9am. **Older siblings are able to go through their younger siblings doors to help them get into school on time.**

The morning register is taken by 9:00am. Pupils arriving after the register has been taken but before 9:15am are recorded as late. If you arrive later than 9am, we ask you take your child(ren) round to the front office to safely sign your children into school.
