Morning Registration

Please be reminded of the morning routines at school, as per our attendance policy, which can be found on the school website. Our school doors open at 8:45am. Please ensure your child arrives at this time so they are not late for the register. The doors close at 8:55am, along with the external school gates, which close promptly at 9am. Older siblings are able to go through their younger siblings doors to help them get into school on time.

The morning register is taken by 9:00am. Pupils arriving after the register has been taken but before 9:15am are recorded as late. If you arrive later than 9am, we ask you take your child(ren) round to the front office to safely sign your children into school.
