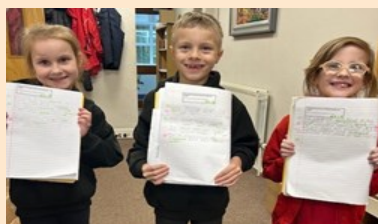

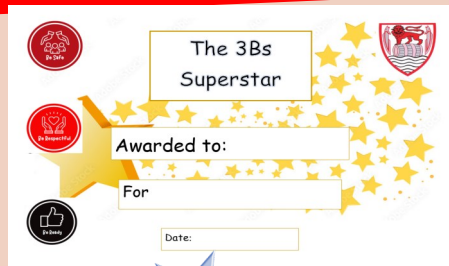
SPOTLIGHT THIS WEEK IS

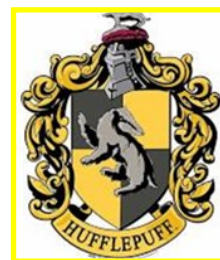
