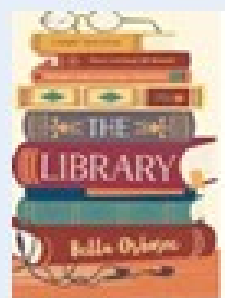
Silly Science!

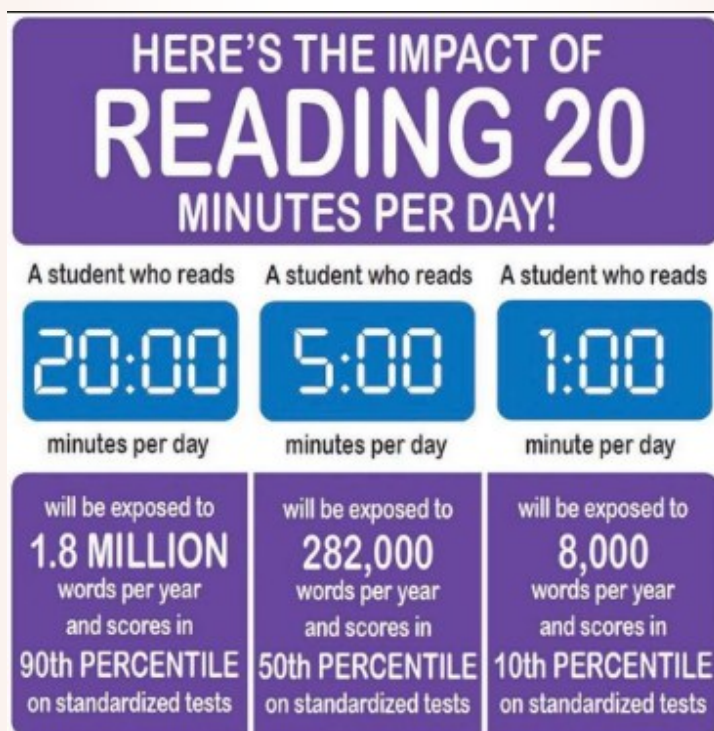


Helicopter surprise!

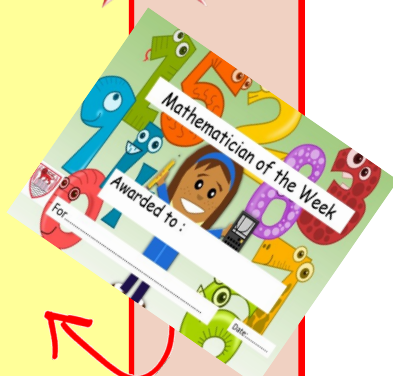

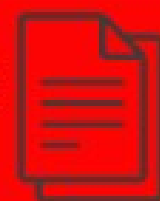

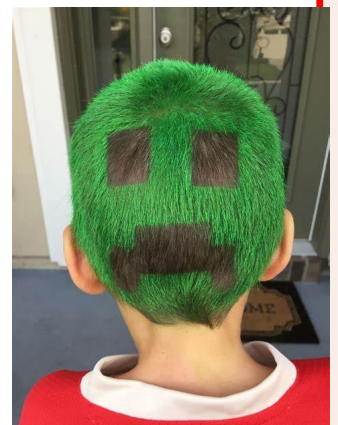
