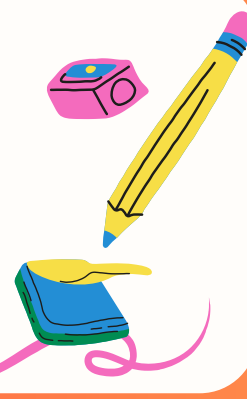

If so, please get in touch with your class teacher!



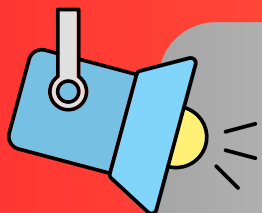
Medical Information

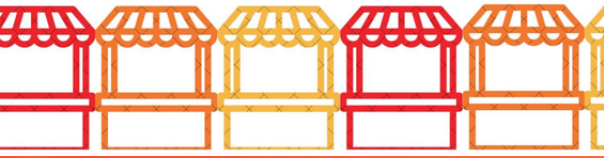
